



NEW MOVING REGULATIONS

Regulations published on 14 May 2020 by virtue of **Government Gazette 43320** have made the **movement of persons and businesses easier** than the previous regulations allowed for during Level 4.

MOVING REGULATIONS. 7 MAY 2020 These have been repealed.

♦ MOVING REGULATIONS. 14 MAY 2020

Persons moving across provincial, metropolitan or district boundaries, on a once off basis, during alert level 4 is permitted for the following:

- A person relocating to a new place of residence;
- Movement due to domestic violence;
- Businesses relocating to new premises.

♦ WHAT IS REQUIRED TO MOVE?

Persons eligible to move during this period will be required to obtain a permit issued by the head of court or a station commander of a police station or a person designated by him or her. The permit must correspond with Form 1 attached to the Directive. A copy of the mentioned permit is attached.

Supporting documents needed to obtain the permit include:

- Lease agreement with date of expiry or date of commencement of new lease;
- Proof of purchase of residence and occupation date;
- Details of persons who are part of the household who will be moving;
- Transfer documents attesting change of ownership;
- Domestic violence order;
- Proof of change of occupation of business premises.
- ♦ The new regulations are far wider than the repealed regulations and allow movement beyond the 7 June 2020 window period.
